Rinse the insides with water.</li> <li>2. Cut the cartons open and let dry.</li> <li>3. Bundle together and tie with string.</li> </ol>   | <h3>Corrugated Cardboard</h3> <p>Please collapse or cut boxes and bundle them together with string.</p>   |
| <h3>Glass Bottles</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Remove the caps.</li> <li>2. Rinse the insides with water.</li> <li>3. Place bottles in the yellow container.</li> </ol> <p>Metal bottlecaps are Unburnable Garbage.</p> | <h3>Cans</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Rinse the insides with water.</li> <li>2. Place cans in the blue container.</li> </ol> <p>Aerosol cans, gas canisters, paint cans, and cans that cannot be cleaned are Unburnable Garbage.</p> | <h3>PET Bottles</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Remove the cap and label.</li> <li>2. Rinse the insides with water.</li> <li>3. Crush bottles, if possible.</li> <li>4. Place the bottles in the green container or in the plastic net.</li> </ol> <p>Caps and labels are Burnable Garbage.</p> | <h3>Styrofoam Trays &amp; Cups</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Remove labels, stickers, or plastic wrap.</li> <li>2. Rinse the trays with water and let dry thoroughly.</li> <li>3. Place them in the gray container.</li> </ol> <p>Dirty trays, packing Styrofoam, Seafood box or non-Styrofoam trays or cups are Burnable Garbage.</p> |

Please put it in a different bag and take it out.</li> </ul> |
